

# The 2017 Student Periodical Health Checkup Guide

1. The School Health and Safety Act mandates that all students in Japan receive an annual health checkup. Accordingly, all students who are enrolled at Tokyo University of the Arts are obliged to receive one to confirm their health conditions.
2. The university will NOT issue health certificates for students who failed to receive a periodical health checkup.
3. Students are encouraged to attend a session on the day designated as below. However, in case you can't make it on the day, you may come to receive a checkup on any day between **April 3,6,7 (Note that the April 4 sessions accept only the first-year undergraduate students and students who will take part in a teaching training program)**
  - \* No prior procedures are required. Please be aware that there are two separate sessions for male and female students each day.
  - \* If you intend to participate in a teaching training program in 2016, attend a session on April 4 in principle.
4. Those who intend to take a special medical examination of ionizing radiation or mercury, for example, should also attend a session according to the list below.
5. Make sure to bring your student ID card, which will be needed at the reception. If you don't have it, make sure to have your student number at hand.

## 【Checkup items】

1. Height 2. Weight 3. Vision 4. Blood pressure 5. Consultation with an internist 6. Chest X-ray

\* New students of the undergraduate, master's and doctoral programs are to receive all the items.

\* Students who need a health certificate for teacher training or elderly care programs, submitting to another program, employment, scholarship are to receive all the items.

\* Students other than the above mentioned are to take items 1 to 5. Although 6 is optional, students are recommended to take it as well for the benefit of early detection of potential health problems.

Note1: Female students are asked to bring a plain T-shirt (without prints or embroideries) for a chest X-ray.

Note2: Do not bring any valuable items to the venue. You are responsible for your own belongings.
