

The General instructions for the 2018 Student Health Checkup and the results

<What to bring>

1. **Student ID** (If you haven't received your ID card yet, bring a document that shows your provisional student number)
2. **Health Checkup Questionnaire**
 - New undergraduate students : You will receive a questionnaire sheet at the student orientation, which needs to be completed beforehand and brought to the checkup venue.
 - Current students • Other new students : You can obtain a questionnaire sheet by yourself through the following methods;
 - A. Download from the website of the health care service center
 - B. Pick up at the health care service center in Ueno or its branch in Toride
3. **Student Health Record**
 - New undergraduate students: You will receive a blank record at the student orientation. Please complete the space within thick lines and bring the completed record to the checkup venue
 - Current students: If you have attended a past health checkup at TUA, your record is ready to be picked up at the checkup venue. If you have never attended a health examination at TUA, you will receive an empty form to fill in at the venue.
 - Other new students: You will receive an empty form to fill in at the venue
4. **Glasses • Contact lenses** (If you wear them)

<What you should wear>

- Wear a two-piece outfit (No one-piece or overalls as they are inconvenient for examination)
- **Wear or bring a plain T-shirt** (Without lamé, prints, embroideries, buttons, metal ornaments, etc.)
- If your hair is shoulder-length or longer, tie it.
- Avoid wearing accessories.

<Important Notice>

- If you are currently pregnant or there is a possibility that you may be pregnant, do not undergo a chest X-ray.
- If you need special consideration during the checkup, please make a prior inquiry to HCSC.

« Health Certificate • Checkup Results »

1. **If you received a letter inviting you to a “follow-up examination” at the end of the health checkup** . . .
 - **Students of Ueno/Toride/Senju:** Please make an appointment for a medical consultation at the Health Care Service Center (HCSC) in Ueno or its branch in Toride.
 - **Students of Yokohama:** Please make an appointment for a consultation at a near-by medical institution as instructed in the letter. You may also visit HCSC in Ueno. * Prior booking in person or by phone is essential.
2. **If you need a “follow-up examination” as the result of a chest X-ray or consultation etc.** . . . You will be contacted by the Health Care Service Center later.
3. **If your results said “not particular” or if you have finished a “follow-up examination”** . . . Your health certificate will be issued by the automated certificate issuing machines on campus around after May 21, 2018, and it is available until one day prior to the date of graduation.
4. HCSC may contact you by phone or e-mail if case it needs to inform you of any abnormalities found in the check-up or to ask about the information provided in the questionnaire. You are kindly requested to respond to such a call, as it is important to ensure your safety and health on campus.
