


The 2026 Student Periodical Health Checkup Guide

Periodical health checkups are required by the School Health and Safety Law for all students. Be sure to have a checkup to confirm your health condition.

1. Eligible	ALL Students(undergraduate, master and doctoral programs,practical music course,research students,credited auditors) *Including those on leave of absence
2. Contents	①High ②Weight ③Vision ④Hearing test ⑤Blood pressure ⑥Consultation with an internist ⑦Chest X-ray ⑧Urinalysis(New students only)*⑨Chest X-rays are required for regular new students, Teacher Training Program participants.
3. Belongings &Clothing	①Student ID card ②Eyeglasses and/or contact lenses(users only) ③Urine collected in the morning at home (New regular students only) · Wear socks; you will take off your shoes at the site. Wear shoes that are easy to take off. ·For chest x-ray, wear or bring a plain T-shirt with both sides (no lame, print, embroidery, buttons, metal fittings, bra top, etc.).

5. Date and Place	You are required to take a checkup at the date allotted in the table below. In case you can't come on your date, you may receive the checkup on a day outside your target category. (There is no need to contact us about rescheduling.) Students participating in the Teacher Training Program in 2026 must attend the April 1 session.

6. Precautions

①Chest X-ray

- All the new students in each program and the students who need a health certificate for the following reasons and MUST receive chest X-ray: a teacher training program, an elderly care program, other programs, employment, scholarships.
- Other students can take it on a voluntary basis, but we recommend that you take for early detection of abnormalities such as tuberculosis.
- If you are pregnant or think you might be, DO NOT take chest X-ray exam.

②Notes on taking a urine sample ※ New regular students only

- Please be sure to pick up the urine collection container at the Educational Affairs Section of your department at least one day before the day of the health checkup.
- Whether your checkup is scheduled in the morning or in the afternoon, be sure to take the first morning urine sample at home on the day of the checkup. Otherwise samples will not be accepted
- Take urine from the middle of the stream (discard the first and end of the stream).
- Avoid strenuous exercise and binge eating from the day before the checkup until the urine collection on the morning of the checkup.
- If you are in (or shortly before or after) your menstruation period, DO NOT take a sample on the day of the checkup for avoiding inaccurate result. Instead, please submit on another date to be announced at the day of the checkup.



③Precautions on the day

- If you are sick or have a fever on the day of the checkup, you may receive the checkup on a day outside your target category. (There is no need to contact us about rescheduling.). If you have cough or runny nose symptoms, be sure to wear a mask.

④Results of the check-up

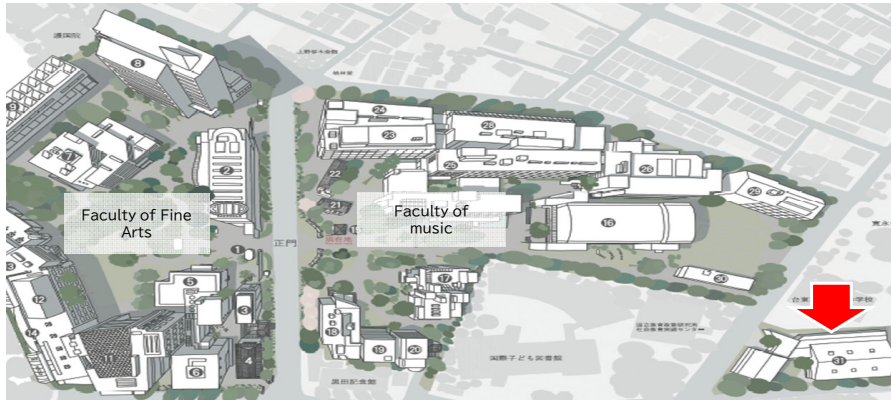
- Make sure to answer the message from the Health Care Service Center by phone or email. The test results may require you to take an additional examination.
- The results can be issued by the automatic certificate issuing machine from [UENO: Early May/Toride&Yokohama: Early JUNE (to be announced)]
- Please be sure to check the results at the automatic certificate issuing machine for your own health management.

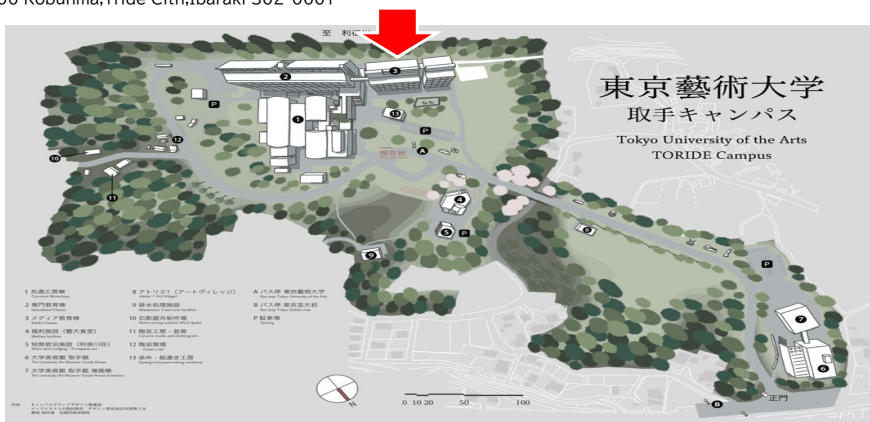
