授業料免除制度の新設について（私費外国人留学生対象）

東京藝術大学では、優れた外国人留学生の受け入れを一層促進し、安心して学業・研究に専念できる環境を整備するため、令和9年度4月以降に本学に入学する外国人留学生を対象とした新たな授業料免除制度を創設します。

この新たな免除制度は、学力基準による選考を基本とし、入試成績、学業成績、修学状況、及び学術・芸術活動等の優れた業績等を総合的に評価のうえ、特に優秀と認められる学生に対して授業料免除を実施するものです。

1. 制度創設の趣旨

優秀な留学生の受け入れの一層の促進を図るとともに、学修・研究意欲の向上及び国際的な教育研究環境の充実に資することを目的として実施するものです。

2. 申請資格

次のすべてに該当する者

・在留資格「 留学 」を有する者（または取得見込みの者）
・国費外国人留学生、外国政府派遣留学生等、授業料の支援を受けていない者
・他の機関による授業料支援（授業料相当額の支給）を受けていない者

以下の者は申請対象外

- ・非正規生
- ・修得単位数が標準単位数に満たない者
- ・留年している者
- ・休学期間を除く在学期間が修業年限を超えた者

※但、超過期間が1年間の者に限り、その理由がやむを得ない事由と認定された場合は対象となり得る

※学長が真にやむを得ない事由があると認めた場合に限り更なる1年の特例有

家計急変が生じた場合

- ・主たる生計維持者が亡くなった場合に限り家計急変者として申請が可能

※死亡した翌期および翌々期について申請可（結婚し配偶者（パートナー等）のいる者を除く）

3. 免除対象者

新入生	学部・別科・大学院共通	入学試験の成績が学科（学部）、専修（別科）、専攻（修士）、研究領域（博士）内において合格した私費外国人留学生全体の上位 1/2 以内となった者
在校生	学部	前学期までの累計 GPA が所属する学年の上位 1/2 以上の者
	別科	前学期までの成績が所属する学年の上位 1/2 以上の者
	大学院共通	前学期までの「優」以上の単位合計が総修得単位の 75%以上ある者

4. 選考方法

次の内容を総合的に評価します。

・入試成績（新入生）
・学業成績
・修学状況
・学術・芸術活動等における優れた業績
・その他、大学が必要と認める事項

5. 免除区分

評価の結果、総合評価の高い者から順位付けを行い、予算の範囲内で全額又は半額の免除を決定します。

6. 適用開始時期

令和 9（2027）年度入学者より適用となります。

※令和 9（2027）年度以前の入学者は、現在の課程を卒業するまで、現行制度による授業料免除の対象です。（新設される授業料免除制度には申請できません。）

7. 申請時期および申請方法等

申請時期：（現行の授業料免除と同じ） 前期：4 月上旬 後期：9 月上旬

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IMPORTANT NOTICE

Establishment of a New Tuition Waiver Program for Privately Financed International Students

Tokyo University of the Arts will establish a new tuition waiver program for international students enrolling at the University from April 2027 (Academic Year 2027) onward. This program aims to further promote the acceptance of outstanding international students and to provide an environment in which they can focus on their studies and research.

The new tuition waiver program will be primarily based on academic merit. Applicants will be comprehensively evaluated based on entrance examination results, academic performance, study progress, and outstanding achievements in academic, artistic, or other related activities. Tuition waivers will be granted to students who are recognized as particularly excellent.

Purpose of the Program

This program is intended to:

- Further promote the acceptance of outstanding international students
- Encourage academic and research excellence
- Enhance the University's international educational and research environment

Eligibility Requirements

Applicants required to meet all of the following eligibility :

- Hold (or be expected to obtain) a 'Student' status of residence in Japan
- Not receive tuition support through a Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship, a foreign government scholarship, or any other program that covers tuition fees
- Not receive tuition assistance equivalent to tuition fees from another organization

The following students are not eligible to apply:

- Non-regular students
- Students who have not earned the required number of credits
- Students who are repeating a year
- Students who have been enrolled beyond the standard course period

Exception:

- Those who have repeated a year or have exceeded the standard period of study for less than one year may be accepted for some special reason.
- In addition, a further one-year exception may be granted only when the President of the University determines that there are truly unavoidable reason.

Cases of Sudden Changes in Household Finances

Students whose primary financial supporter has passed away within one year prior to the tuition fee payment deadline may apply on the grounds of a sudden change in household circumstances.

*However, this criterion does not apply to cases where the applicant or his/her spouse is financially independent and identified as the key income producer of the household, even if the applicant's parents have passed away.

Eligible Students

	Category	Eligible Applicants
New student	Undergraduate, Practical Music Course, Graduate Students	Students whose entrance examination results rank within the top 50% of all successful applicants in their department (undergraduate), Research Division (Practical Music Course), major (Master's Program), or research field (Doctoral Program).
Current student (enrolling in 2027 AY and thereafter)	Undergraduate	Students whose cumulative GPA up to the previous semester is in the top 50% or higher of their year group.
	Practical Music Course	Students whose academic record up to the previous term place them in the top 50% or higher of their year group.
	Graduate Students	Students who have earned grades of "Excellent (Yu)" or higher in at least 75% of their total accumulated credits.

Selection Process

The following factors will be comprehensively evaluated:

- Entrance examination results (for new students)
- Academic performance
- Study progress and enrollment status
- Outstanding achievements in academic, artistic, or related activities
- Other factors deemed necessary by the University

Categories of Tuition Waiver

Applicants will be ranked according to their overall evaluation. Based on this ranking and within the limits of the available budget, a full tuition fee exemption or a half tuition fee exemption will be granted.

Effective Date

This new program will apply to students enrolling in the Academic Year 2027 and thereafter.

Note: *Students enrolling in the 2026 Academic Year or earlier are eligible for tuition fee exemptions under the current system until they graduate from their current course. (Cannot apply for the new tuition fee exemption program.)

Application Period and Procedures

Application Period:

- 1st Semester: Early April
- 2nd Semester: Early September

Details regarding the application procedures and required documents will be announced on the University's website and through other official channels in late February.
